**All the participating teams need to bring their complete Badminton kit [Racket, Non-Marking Shoes, Dress, Shuttle (Yonex AS2 (only) Feather Shuttle Cocks)].**

Dates for Tournament: 5<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025 to 8<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025

Reporting Date & time: 4<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2025 05.00 PM onwards

Meeting of Team Coach & Managers: 04/AUGUST/2025 at 07.00 PM

Opening Ceremony: 5<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025

Closing Ceremony: 8<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025

Lodging/Boarding: Each participant/school must remit Rs. 500.00 per head per day against lodging and boarding. Money will be collected/deposited against boarding and lodging on full day basis and no part payment will be collected or deposited and the participating schools will not insist to refund for part payment. Dining in the mess arranged by the Host School is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay by the school premises accommodation.

(Team in need of stay facility must inform till 20<sup>th</sup> JULY 2025) **(Proforma Enclosed) – Minimum Four days boarding and lodging charges will have to be paid in advance.**

- 1). Inauguration of Cluster V badminton tournament on 5<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025. It is mandatory for all the schools participation in tournament to attend the inaugural ceremony in proper track suit or school uniform along with the school flag and one banner bearing the name of their school for ceremony.
- 2). The participants must carry their I-card signed by the principal.
- 3). The team coach must carry group photograph of the team along with the Principal, Team Manager and Coach.
- 4). Team Coach and Manager also must carry their school I-card.



## **CBSE CLUSTER V BADMINTON TOURNAMENT 2025-26**

### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

1. The Entry forms, travel plan, student participation details and attested Identity card format which are already given on the CBSE website [www.cbseacademic.in](http://www.cbseacademic.in), should be filled in capital letters and sent immediately to school mail id:- [apscalld@gmail.com](mailto:apscalld@gmail.com)
2. Each school will send one female staff member, for girl's along with their team.
3. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco, smoking is strictly prohibited during the conduct of tournament and stay in the school/ accommodation. Anyone who violates the rules will be immediately removed from the school campus and disciplinary action will be taken by the host school.
4. Any damage done to the property of the school during the stay by the participants will have to be compensated for, by the respective school.
5. **The participants are not allowed to touch the materials which are costly and sensitive like-Smart Boards, CCTV Camera, Window glass, Fans, Lights, ACs, Almirah etc.**
6. The participants are not allowed to wear or bring any costly ornaments, The School will not be held responsible for the loss of any such valuable article during the entire stay during the tournament.
7. It is compulsory for all the participants along with their accompanying staff to attend the inaugural and valedictory ceremony.
8. Each school must issue an identity card to each player of its school, separately for each of the discipline in which students intends to participate as per the format of the CBSE.
9. No players shall be permitted to participate in the CBSE nationals without their original identity card the principal of the respective participant school.
10. All the participants schools have to deposit Rs. 2000/- as caution money which is refundable. (For loss or any damage in Organizing school property).



## **CBSE CLUSTER V BADMINTON TOURNAMENT 2025-26**

1. CBSE Inter-School Badminton Tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of the Badminton Association of India (BAI) with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school can send one team comprising maximum of four players, in the category of 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in category.
3. All the participants must carry their valid age proof certificate and school/CBSE Board Identity-card.
4. All the matches will be played on indoor courts with proper lighting arrangements.
5. In Team Championship, the order of play shall be, Singles - Doubles - Singles.
6. All the matches that are played on “league basis” – shall be of best of one game of 30 points with change of side at 15 points. The player that reaches first at 30 points, wins the match.
7. All the matches that are played on “knock-out basis” - shall be of best of three games of 15 points each, & a match is won with the difference of 02 points. In case, of 14 point - there will be a golden point, the team which completes the 15 points first, that will be declared winner.
8. At Zone Level all the matches will be played strictly on knock-out basis. In case the numbers of teams in a particular age category are less, the championship in that category may be organized on league cum knock out basis.
9. No change shall be permitted in the composition of team from the Zonal Level to the National Level.
10. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams, that have qualified to participate in National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Proforma.
11. National Championship will be conducted on League cum knock-out basis for which all the teams will be divided into different pools.
12. At National level, one day of the Championship event shall be dedicated exclusively to the Individual Championship.
13. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way manner that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches further.

**Guidelines:**

1. We request you to forward the entries earliest by 20<sup>th</sup> JULY, 2025.
2. Late entries will not be entertained in any case. Consent tell can only be sent on E-mail:- apscalld@gmail.com

Telephonic consent will not be accepted.

3. Kindly facilitate in sending consent form & the contact details {complete address, telephone no. , E- mail address etc} for better coordination & successful smooth conduct of event.
4. No team will be allowed to participate without Team manager/ Coach/Physical Education teacher designated by the participating school's principal.



5. Participants are requested not to bring costly items such as Jewellery, mobile, camera, iPod and other electronic gadgets, as the use of these items is strictly prohibited in campus during the stay. School will not be responsible for the loss of any such articles during the stay.
6. Boarding and lodging will be available from a day prior to event.
7. The entry forms, travel plan, student participation detail and attested identity card form attached filled in CAPITAL LETTERS should reach us on or before 20<sup>th</sup> JULY 2025
8. Each school must issue an identity card to every player of its school & accompanying staff.
9. All the schools have to deposit Rs. 2000/- as caution money which is refundable. This money will not be refundable in case of any damage or loss to the organization school property caused by a particular school team participating.
10. A mandatory Team Managers and Coaches will be held one day prior to the event at on 4<sup>th</sup> AUGUST, 2025 at 7 pm in the school Auditorium hall, to cover all the necessary preliminary remarks/instructions.
11. Teams without proper eligibility forms will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.

Team Manager will be responsible for the conduct of their respective team on the field and in the school premises. Indiscipline by an athlete/player /member will lead to disqualification and the athlete/player/member may be asked to leave the premises immediately.

1. The organizers reserve the right to debar a player / coach / Manager from the competition arena for unruly behavior / interference in the smooth conduction of completion conduct of the events.
2. Protest of any nature must reach the Organizing Committee in writing, within one hour of the declaration of the result. It should be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 2000/- {non-refundable}. The decision taken by jury will be final and binding for all concerned teams and managers.
3. It is the responsibility of the respective team manager to bring the sick/ injured player to the First -Aid Committee for help.
4. Spot entry/ changes will not be permitted.
5. Any non-designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter anyhow at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the premises
6. The boarding charges shall not exceed Rs. 500/- per head per day including food, **It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the organizing school, it is mandatory. Only vegetarian food will be served.**

7. **No outsider, including any extra member, parents, friends, or relatives, will be allowed inside the school premises.**
8. Participation in March past is compulsory for all participating teams failing by which their right to participate can be forfeited.
9. It is the responsibility of the participating school/teams staying outside, the campus to collect information in regard to matches/fixtures/program etc. before hand & will on time for smooth conduct of event.

In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent, it should be informed by the Principal of participating school in writing. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying officials.  
No team shall be accompanied by any parent.

However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information must be provided by the participating school on the school letter head signed by Principal.

No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.

The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid Identity Card issued by their school Principal. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the organization school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

### **Withdrawing School from the tournament**

If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from the tournament/ meet, it shall give a written request for withdraw to the Organizing Secretary of the School.

School withdrawing without information/ request to the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs. 2000/-.

### **Eligibility criteria:-**

**Age:** The athlete/ player should be within the particular age group calculated on 31st December of the year of competition.

1. Only bonafide students shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-school tournaments/meets. Finding any non bonafide student shall lead to disqualification of the team.
2. A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.
3. Incomplete/ fake information in any respect provided by the participating team is liable for disqualification of the team.
4. Any violation in eligibility (over age or impersonation) shall be dealt according to rules laid by CBSE.

5. The original eligibility Proforma of the Athletes/Players/Team qualifying to participate from Zone level to National level will be certified by the Organizing school at the zone level as the case may be and forwarded to the National Organizing School, immediately after their Zone level competition is over.

6. Medical checkup may also be applied by the jury of Appeal appointed by the Organizing school in the cases of overage of the participants.

7. All the supporting papers verifying the age of the player, etc in original, as per the CBSE Guidelines & Rules shall be carried personally by the Team Manager/Coach while reporting for participation.

8. The player's right to participate forfeits if he fails to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

Any team/ athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament/meet shall not be permitted to participate.

#### **Eligibility/ Entry Proforma:**

Every school shall supply to the host school on arrival the signed copy of the eligibility Proforma filled in online.

#### **Disqualifications:**

A player/team may be disqualified/struck off for the following reasons.

1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
3. Misbehavior with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
5. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
6. Damaging the school property.
7. Indiscipline during the opening and closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.
8. Non participation in March Past.

The organizing school in no case shall show the eligibility Proforma or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only jury of appeal's prerogative to verify all the documents.

**Protest**

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.2000/- (Non Refundable)

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following members.

1. Principal, Organizing School
2. Sports Officer
3. CBSE Observer
4. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue.

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is upheld, the protest fees shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding. The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Dy. Director (Sports) CBSE.

**Medals and Certificates**

No Participation Certificate shall be given to a player/team that does not play after reporting.

**Umpires/Referees/Game Officials**

Decision of the game officials is final.
